

About the WASH Pledge

WASH Pledge commitment:

By signing the Pledge, companies commit to:

- Implementing access to safe water, sanitation and hygiene at the workplace at an appropriate level of standard for all their employees in <u>all premises under direct company control and</u> within a time-frame of 3 years
- <u>Supporting partners across our value chains and communities</u> <u>that surround our workplaces</u>

The Pledge adheres to access to WASH as per WHO standards and international best practices.

2 versions of Pledge:

- WASH Pledge 1.0 focused on WASH @ workplace
- WASH Pledge 2.0 focuses on WASH @ workplace, value chain and communities

How do I implement the WASH Pledge?



How do I get started? <u>Step 1</u>

• Establish a baseline of understanding of current WASH situation for your company


- Understand global and local standards, leading practice, laws/regulations for WASH access
- Understand the current situation of WASH access across operations, supply chains and communities where you operate – via enterprise wide audit
- Identify hot spots for action

WASH Pledge self-assessment tool

<u>Step 2:</u> Perform a self-assessment audit for your company


<u>Step 3:</u> Identify hot spots for action / prioritize gaps

- Tool to assess status of WASH
- Rationale for scoring and identification of gaps and recommendations



WASH Pledge Implementation & Improvement

<u>Step 4:</u> Develop and implement an improvement plan



How WASH Pledge is being implemented

Various initiatives for managing the implementation

- **Training** for cleaning personnel, **awareness raising** activities for employees, or "fine-tuning" of systems and review mechanisms
- Link WASH to **KPI** of plant performance/ **sustainability frameworks.**
- Innovating through water saving **technologies**, treatment options, **monitoring and reporting mechanisms**.
- Integrated action plans in a **web-based software**
- Extended the coverage of Pledge to **contractual employees**/ Some plan to extend to their **supply chains and partners**.

<u>Step 5:</u> Disclose and Communicate WASH improvement actions & achievements
